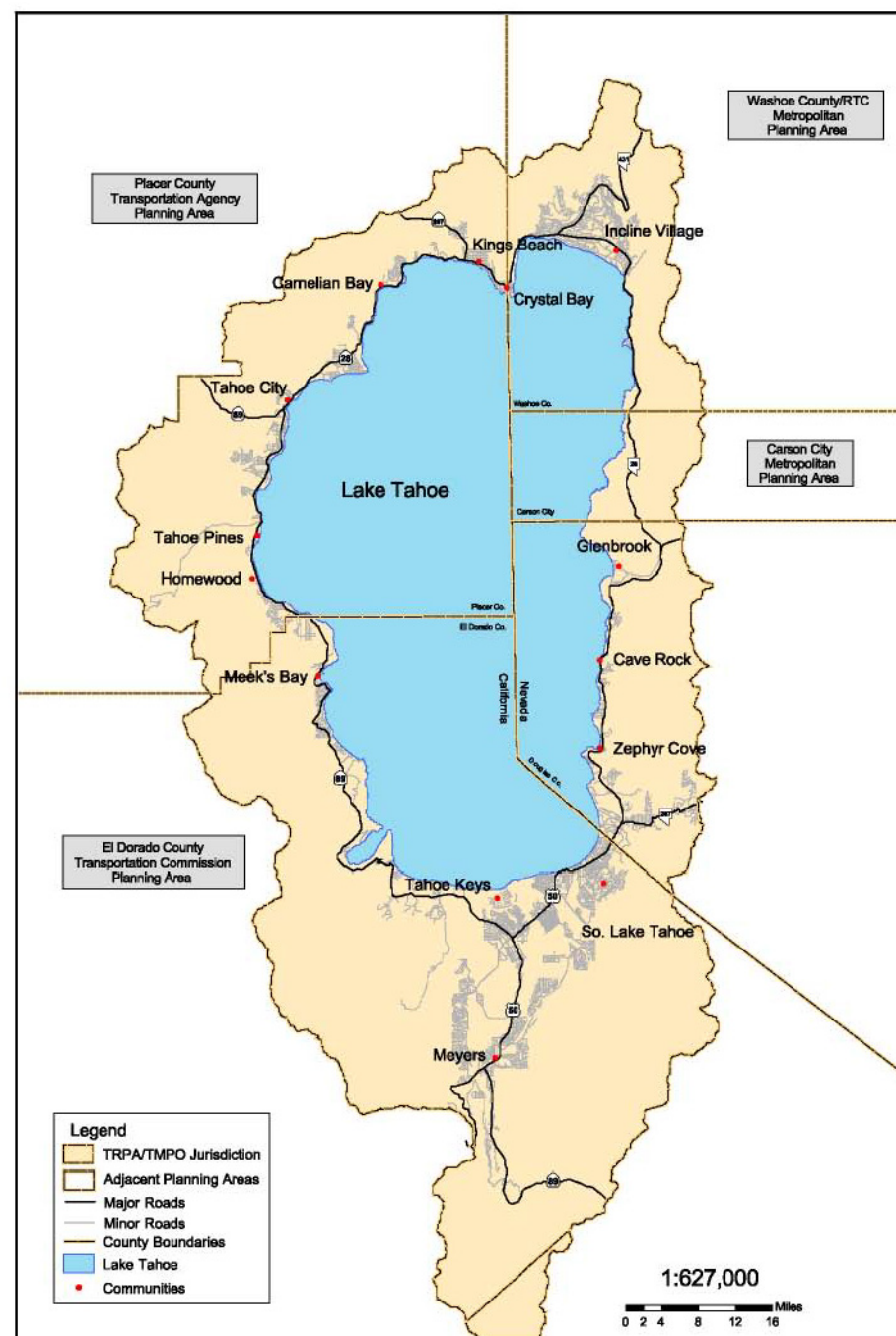

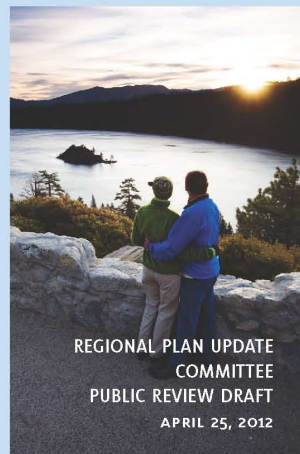


- Buildout projected population up to 750,000

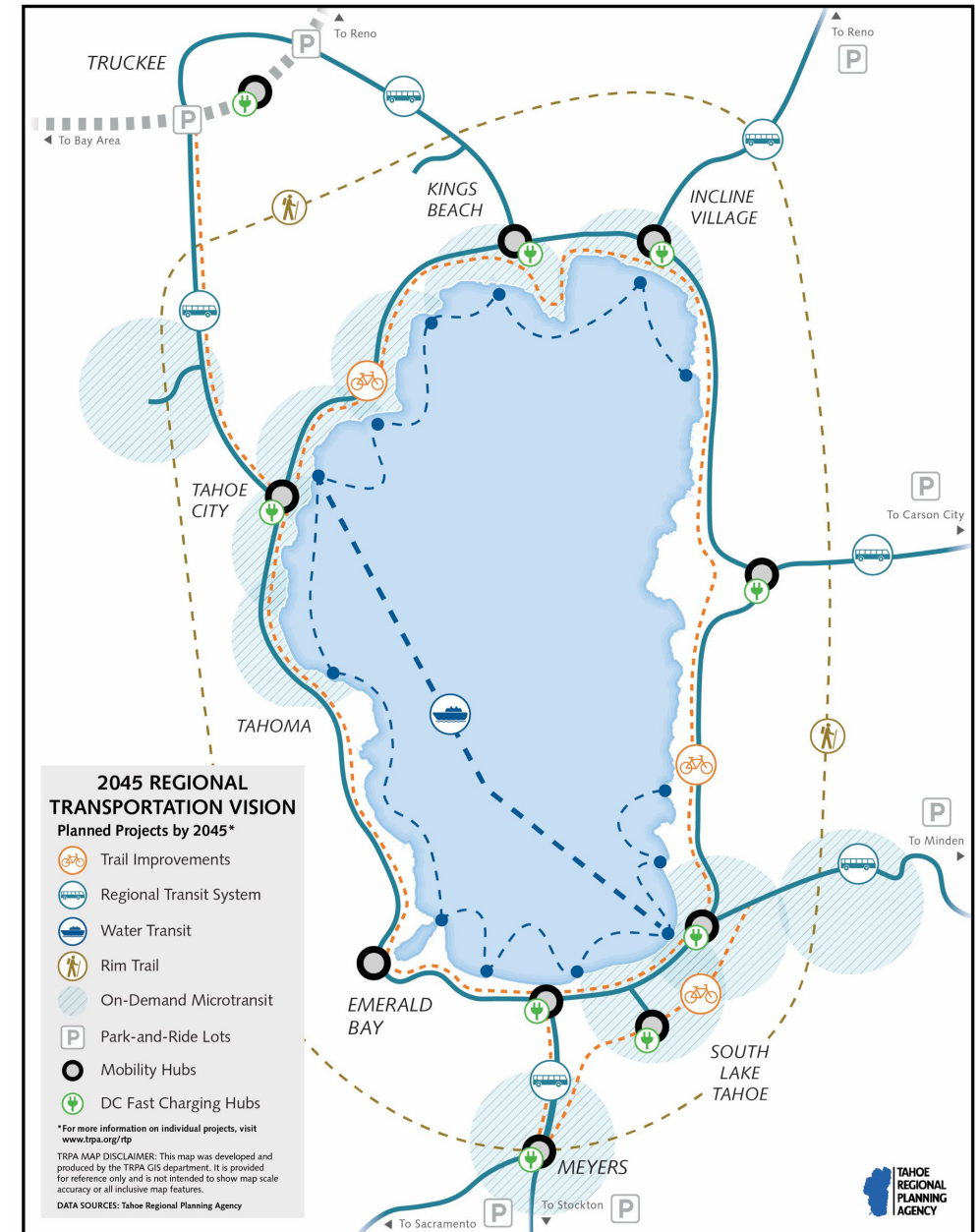

Tahoe Transportation District Background

- The Tahoe Transportation District (TTD) created by Article IX of the 1980 Tahoe Regional Planning Compact
- TTD and TRPA are the two agencies who are responsible for leading regional transportation for the Lake Tahoe Region.
- Other transportation partners at Tahoe are the local governments, the two state departments of transportation, and the private sector.
