








# Climate Refuge





Population Change by Community: 2010 to 2020













#### **Travel Time**

- 12 Segments in the Tahoe Region
- Travel times vary between season
- Local impacts from weather and construction
- Weekend vs. weekday travel patterns
- Most travel times are unchanged over past 5 years





# **Congestion Monitoring**






### Possibly Why Tahoe Feels More Crowded

- Increases in second home use
- Increases in day-use visitation
- People are recreating and staying at different places
  - More people at previously "local's spots" because of information availability
  - Short-term rentals in neighborhoods
- Changes in travel time and behavior
  - Parking lots fill up earlier...so it feels like it is more popular
  - Roadside parking
  - Commute patterns






#### Vacant Homes as a Percentage of Housing Units










### Recreation Visits: Sand Harbor

Sand Harbor Visitors- NV State Parks



### Sand Harbor Fall Weekend Trips


Fall Weekend Trips Ending at Sand Harbor
