Proposed Code Changes: Accessory Dwelling Units



## Current ADU Regulations

Only on parcels of 1-acre or greater

Only 1 per parcel

Must notice neighbors



## Proposed Changes

Parcel Size: No size limit

2 ADUs per parcel

Permitting: Noticing is the same as for other single-family uses

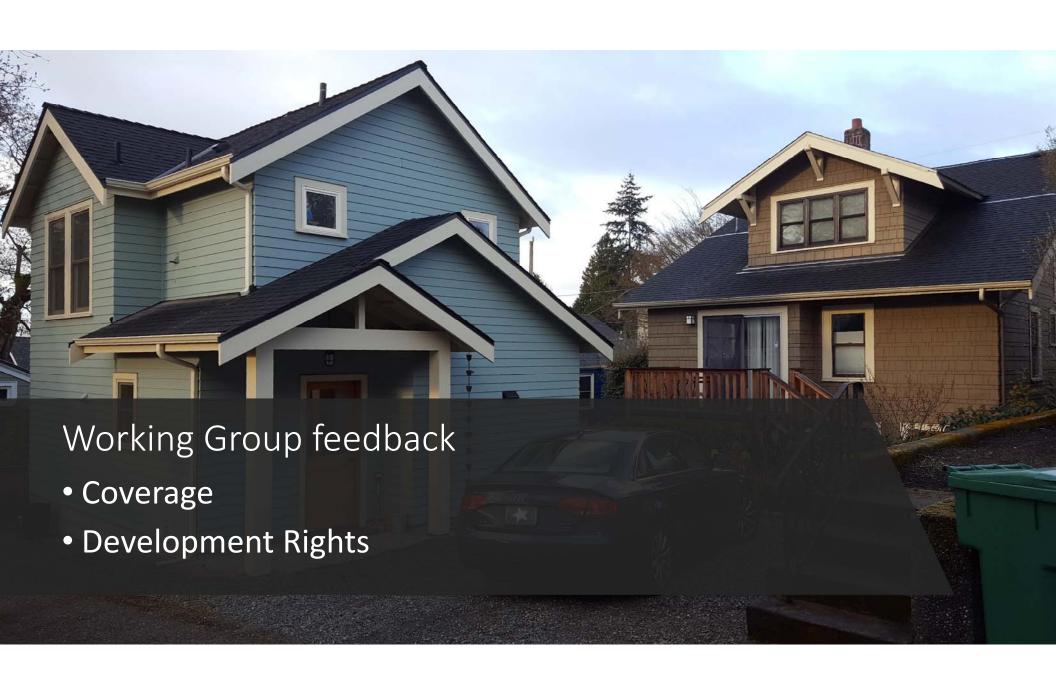
