ESTIMATED FUNDING & YEARS

Initial Cycle of \$296.5M:

1. State General Fund - \$148M
2. PROTECT - provides CA \$49.5M per year for 3 years

Projects in the first cycle may be programmed in Fiscal Years 23-24, 24-25, and 25-26.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Purpose: to provide competitive grants to local agencies for the development and implementation of capital projects adapting local transportation infrastructure to climate changes.

Distribution: In addition to State funds, the program is supported by the IIJA created resilience formula program, the Promoting Resilient Operations for Transformative, Efficient, and Cost-saving Transportation (PROTECT). The PROTECT funds provided to California will be administered through the LTCAP Program.

ELIGIBLE COSTS & PHASES

Any phase of a capital project:

- Project approval & environmental documentation
- Plans, specifications, & estimate
- ROW
- Construction

Maximum request of \$50M

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS



- MPOs, RTPAs, and CTCs
- Joint Powers Authority
- Local Transportation Authority
- City, County, or a city and a county
- A federally recognized Native American tribe

Potential Tahoe Applicants: City of SLT, El Dorado County, Placer County, TTD, TRPA

MATCH REQUIRED

20%, non-federal match required

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS & ACTIVITIES

Eligible Activities:

- Resiliency Improvements: improve infrastructure to withstand one or more elements of weather or natural disaster, such as improving drainage, storm surge & flood protection.
- Community resilience and evacuation route
- At-risk coastal infrastructure
- System resilience elements

Some Eligible Facilities:

- Roads, streets, and parkways
- Rights-of-way, bridges, railroad-highway crossings, tunnel drainage structures, signs, guardrails, and protective structures in connection with a highway.
- Tribal transportation facilities
- Public transportation facilities that may include transit facilities, active transportation facilities, and public parking structures
