Increase safety and security for all users of Tahoe's transportation system.








Annual Ridership for TTD, TART, TART Connect and Lake Link

Measure Performance


- Annual totals for 2018 to October of 2023
- Getting back to 2018 totals
- 2023 looks on track to for those 2018 and 2022 totals
- Tart Connect services started in June of 2021*
- Lake Link services started in July of 2022**



Measure Performance

Transit Services by Month - July of 2017 and thru October of 2023

- **TART** fixed route and **TART Connect** serving north shore combined are trending up since May 2020, peaks in winter are exceeding 2018 totals
- **TTD** and **Lake Link** serving south shore primarily, getting back to those 2017/2018 winter peaks.





Measure Performance

Service Trends – Fixed Route

- No population, except for one quarter in 2018, has been served by frequent service
- Regionally 65% of the population is served by basic service (60 min.)

*Note that some microtransit within very small zones may be close to 20-min wait times at certain times of the day however due to this variability this cannot be included in this analysis. Propose to track increase in coverage and hours of service.

Project Focus Areas


- Modifications to the FTIP/STIP project selection process
