# 2023 Federal Transportation Improvement Program

- Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) implements projects in the Regional Transportation Plan
- Financially constrained four-year programming document for FFY 2023 thru 2026
- Updated every two years
- Projects that receive federal funds, are regionally significant, or require a federal action
- Allows for the authorization of funds and the work to proceed
- Amendment includes a major change to the FTIP and processed quarterly

# Amendment 7

## Adds a **Corridor Coordination** Project

- Support Corridor Coordination Efforts Across Multiple Jurisdictions and Stakeholders
- Streamline Project Delivery Process
- Current Funds Support TTD Coordination in the SR28 Corridor
- Support Additional Corridors in future years (i.e.: SR89 and US50)
