ESTIMATED FUNDING & YEARS

\$25M: Administered in 3 rounds, with estimated \$6,600,000 for each round.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Provides funding to help communities identify climate resilience priorities and address planning needs, support the development of a pipeline of climate resilient and reduce future risk.

3 Grant Programs:

1. Adaptation planning grant
2. Regional resilience planning and implementation grant program
3. Extreme heat and community resilience grant program

ELIGIBLE COSTS & PHASES

- Planning
- Minimum of \$25,000 and maximum of \$600,000 award*

*Depending on entity; for local governments, min. of \$150,000 and max. of \$400,000

OPR will consider whether an applicant is in or represents a vulnerable community, including rural communities and tribal lands, in reviewing grant applications and will prioritize funding applications from those communities.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS



- Local Public Entities*: Cities, counties, MPOs, Joint Power Authorities
- Disadvantage Unincorporated Communities (DUCs)
- Community-Based Organizations

**All public entities mentioned above applying for projects targeted at benefitting vulnerable communities should partner with at least 1 community-based organization*

Potential Tahoe Applicants: City of SLT, El Dorado County, Placer County, TRPA

MATCH REQUIRED

No match is required.

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS & ACTIVITIES

Must fit into one or more of the 4 phases below, as defined by the California Adaptation Planning Guide.

Phase 1: Explore, define, initiate

Phase 2: Assess vulnerability

Phase 3: Define adaptation framework and strategies

Phase 4: Implement, monitor, evaluate, and adjust

Project should be consistent with the State's Planning Priorities, State Hazard Mitigation Plan, and/or the 2021 California Climate Adaptation Strategy's priorities

*Implementation of construction projects and environmental studies are **ineligible activities**
