A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CLAIMS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 TO THE TAHOE REGIONAL PLANNING AGENCY, SITTING AS THE REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLANNING AGENCY, FOR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Tahoe Transportation District (TTD) is eligible to apply for and receive funds from the Local Transportation Fund (LTF) for transit capital, transit operating, and road maintenance assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA), sitting as the Regional Transportation Planning Agency (RTPA), has been allocated an estimated amount of \$1,695,553 for the portion of El Dorado County at Lake Tahoe, including the City of South Lake Tahoe, for operating and capital assistance for the south shore transit system for fiscal year 2022-2023.
