ESTIMATED FUNDING & YEARS

Program extended to 2023-2024 with **\$146M**, estimated to support 70 grants.

No less than 50 percent of the CCLGP funds are to fund projects that benefit underserved communities

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The goals of the Clean CA Local Grant Program are to:

- Reduce the amount of waste and debris within public rights-of-way, pathways, parks, transit centers, and other public spaces.
- Enhance, rehabilitate, restore, or install measures to beautify and improve public spaces and mitigate the urban heat island effect.
- Enhance public health, cultural connection, and community placemaking by improving public spaces for walking and recreation.

ELIGIBLE COSTS & PHASES

- Implementation funds
- No minimum, maximum award of \$5M

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS



- Local or regional public agency
- Transit agency
- Federally recognized tribal government
- Nonprofit organizations may partner with above as a sub-applicant*

Potential Tahoe Applicants: City of SLT, El Dorado County, Placer County, TRPA, TTD, League to Save Lake Tahoe*

MATCH REQUIRED

0 to 50%, depending on severity of disadvantaged community surrounding project site.

Local match can be all cash, all third-party in-kind contributions, or a combination of the two.

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS & ACTIVITIES

Eligible Projects:

- Infrastructure related community litter abatement and beautification projects
- Non-infrastructure related community litter abatement events and/or educational programs
- A combination of project types
- Recommended that projects are accessible by a multimodal transportation network

*Underserved Communities requirement: An eligible project should be fully or partially located in an underserved community, demonstrate benefit to an underserved community, and at least 75% of the population surrounding the project site(s) must be underserved. Must meet 1 of the below DAC definitions (on Pg. 8 of [Guidelines](#)):
