### ESTIMATED FUNDING & YEARS

Sustainable Communities Grants: **\$29.5M\***  
\$17M competitive, \$12.5M formula funding, FY 23-24  
\*50% set aside for underserved communities

Climate Adaptation Planning Grants: **\$50M**, FY 23-24  
Strategic Partnership Grants: **\$1.5M**, FY 23-24  
Strategic Partnership – Transit Grants: **\$3M**, FY 23-24

### ELIGIBLE COSTS & PHASES

Planning Grants  
Sustainable Communities: \$100K min, \$700K max  
Climate Adaptation: \$100K min, \$1.5M max  
Strategic Partnerships: \$100K min, \$500K max  
Transit: \$100K min, \$500K max

### MATCH REQUIRED

Sustainable Communities: 11.47%  
Climate Adaptation Planning: 11.47%  
Strategic Partnership: 20%, Transit 11.47%

### ABOUT THE PROGRAM

**Sustainable Communities grants:** State-funded; intended to support and implement Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) Sustainable Communities Strategies (SCS) and to ultimately achieve the State's GHG reduction targets.

*Distributed as competitive and formula.*

**Climate Adaptation Planning grants:** State-funded; to support local and regional identification of transportation-related climate vulnerabilities through the development of climate adaptation plans, as well as project-level adaptation planning to identify adaptation projects and strategies for transportation infrastructure.

*Distributed competitively.*

**Strategic Partnerships and Strategic Partnership Transit grants:** Federal-funded; support Federal Planning Factors and address State highway/transit issues.  
*Distributed competitively to MPOs; only MPOs are eligible as primary applicants.*

- Other Public Transportation Planning Entities

\*For Sustainable Communities, must have compliant Housing Elements & completed Annual Progress Reports

- Active Transportation, Complete Streets, Vision Zero Plans
- Corridor Studies and Plans

- EV Planning
- Climate Vulnerability and Risk Assessments
- Evacuation Planning
