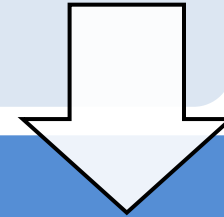

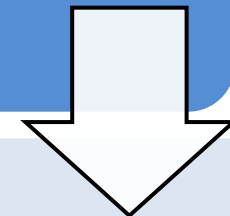

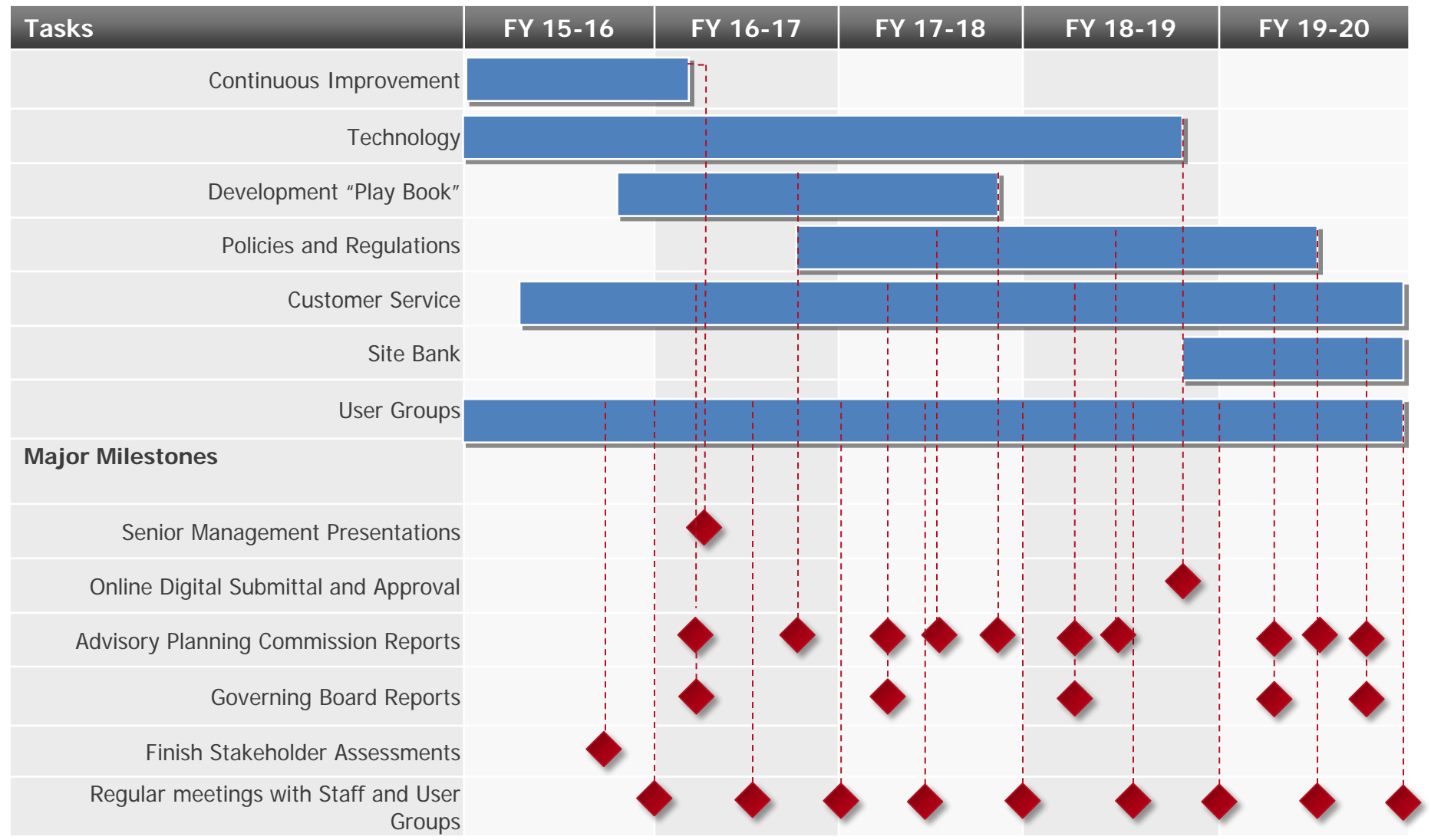
“Welcome Mat” Initiative
