# 1. Corrections to Section/Subsection References within the Code

Amendments correct references to other Sections/Subsections within the Code that are incorrect as adopted.



## 2. Term Definition Corrections/Clarifications

Amendments correct term definitions for consistency and clarity within the Code.

### 3. Appropriate Jurisdictional Reference Corrections

Amendments correct inaccurate or inappropriate jurisdictional references to more clearly and accurately denote Code requirements.
