

Attachment F: Key to fields in found Attachments B, D, E.

82-11 Appearance – A reference number assigned to each standard based on the order in which the standards appear in Resolution 82-11. Standards are not numbered in Resolution 82-11.

Name of standard – Common name given to the standard.

Threshold Category – The category in which the standard can be found Resolution 82-11. Nine categories are identified in Resolution 82-11. Categories are indicated with capital letters and blue background formatting.

Reporting Category – Within each threshold category in Resolution 82-11, standards are organized under sub headers indicated by an underlined header. Examples include: “Deep Water (Pelagic) Lake Tahoe” in Water Quality and “Stream Habitat” in Fisheries.

Adopted TRPA Threshold Standard (TRPA Resolution 82-11) – Text of the standard as it appears in Resolution 82-11. Where multiple standards are listed within a single block of text, the entire block is provided, and the numbered standard is bolded.

Typology – Indicates the overlap type (or types) as defined in the memo from the Science Advisory Council that the standard displays.

Typology explanation – Indicates the standard number and overlap typology type. Numbers refer to the 82-11 appearance number.

Proposed Standard # - A unique alphanumeric number for each threshold standard that corresponds to the proposed technical corrections in attachment D. Standards are numbered sequentially within each threshold category with a one or two letter prefix that indicates the threshold category.

Proposal Explanation – Where there is a proposed technical correction to a standard, the field provides the rationale for the proposal.
