#### Water & Air Quality Improvements

- Improved infrastructure and undergrounding of utilities will:
  - Improve quality of stormwater runoff
  - Improve air quality
  - Improve scenic quality

Request total: \$313,000

Total project cost: \$2,531,00





# South Tahoe Greenway – Upper Truckee Bridge at Johnson Meadow



#### Air Quality Improvement

- Planning for the Upper Truckee River pedestrian crossing
- Will ultimately connect the Greenway Bike Trail from the Tahoe Sierra neighborhood to the "Y".

Request total: \$31,225

Total project cost: \$300,000





# Country Club Heights Stormwater Management and Erosion Control Project



#### SEZ and Water Quality Improvements

- Improve quality of stormwater runoff
- Restoration of Stream Environment
   Zone
- Improve recreation and access opportunities

Request total: \$83,000

Total project cost: \$678,000





# Meyers Stream Environment Zone / Erosion Control Project



### **SEZ Improvements:**

- Improve quality of stormwater runoff
- Creation of SEZ/wetlands

Request total: \$50,000

Total project cost: \$1,127,404





# Oflyng Water Quality Project



#### Water Quality Improvements

- Improve quality of stormwater runoff through additional treatment
- Stabilization of existing eroding slopes and conveyance systems

Request total: \$50,000

Total project cost: \$1,200,000
