### **PUBLIC HEARING ON HEAVENLY PLAN PLUS DECISION ON CONVENTION CENTER PROJECT AT TRPA BOARD MEETING**

**Lake Tahoe Basin – July 21, 2006** – The Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Governing Board will convene Wednesday, July 26, 2006 for its monthly meeting at 9:30 am at the North Tahoe Conference Center in Kings Beach, CA.

Highlights of this month's meeting include a public hearing for Heavenly Mountain Resort's proposed Master Plan Amendment as well as a vote on Project 3, the proposed convention center project in the City of South Lake Tahoe. A public hearing on the Heavenly plan was held in at the TRPA office at last month's meeting as well.

"TRPA, the Forest Service and Heavenly collectively felt it was necessary to provide another opportunity for the public to voice their opinions on the Heavenly Master Plan Amendment since last month's meeting was lengthy and many people could not stay for its entirety," said Angela Moniot, Communications Representative. The Heavenly public hearing is set for a time certain of 1 pm. Public comments can also be provided in writing to TRPA through July 26, 2006.

A vote is expected of the Governing Board on the South Lake Tahoe Redevelopment Project 3. Project applicants made an informational presentation to the board last month to familiarize board members with the project. Additional items on the meeting agenda include a status report on Pathway 2007's place-based planning at 11 am.
