ABC = Highest – Moderate – Lowest Relative Impact

123 = Lowest – Moderate – Highest Relative Difficulty

XYZ = Shortest – Moderate – Longest Time to Outcomes

Themes:           Efficient transit, revise commodities system, focus water clarity efforts, fire safety plan  
                      Coordinated/ Integrated approaches to funding, measurement, goal setting (threshold driven)

Color Legend: **Green** = Highest prospective impact ideas; **Yellow** = Second tier of prospective impact;  
**Red** = Potentially most radical idea earned the highest APC score but assessed as both difficult and long term
