TRPA COLOR NOTES:

I. COLOR: THE COLOR OF THIS STRUCTURE, INCLUDING ANY FENCES ON THE PROPERTY, SHALL BE COMPATIBLE WITH THE SURROUNDINGS. SUBDUED COLORS IN THE EARTHONE AND WOODTONE RANGES SHALL BE USED FOR THE PRIMARY COLOR OF THE STRUCTURE, HUES SHALL BE WITHIN THE RANGE OF NATURAL COLORS THAT BLEND, RATHER THAN CONTRAST, WITH THE EXISTING VEGETATION AND EARTH HUES. EARTHTONE COLORS ARE CONSIDERED TO BE SHADES OF REDDISH BROWN, BROWN, TAN, OCHRE, AND UMBER.

II. ROOFS: ROOFS SHALL BE COMPOSED OF NON-GLARE EARTHTONE OR WOODTONE MATERIALS THAT MINIMIZE REFLECTIVITY.

III. <u>FENCES:</u> WOODEN FENCES SHALL BE USED WHENEVER POSSIBLE. IF CYCLONE FENCE MUST BE USED, IT SHALL BE COATED WITH BROWN OR BLACK VINYL, INCLUDING FENCE POLES.
