Public Presentation of the Brockway Campground Proposal

Mountainside Partners and Sierra Pacific Industries have submitted an application for the first new campground in the Tahoe Basin in over 20 years. Camping provides opportunities for families to connect with nature and one another, and currently, only 2% of existing campsites in the Tahoe Basin are located in North Lake Tahoe. The Brockway Campground will provide a range of camping experiences from traditional tents, to campers, to eco-shelters.

- Meet the TRPA's Regional Plan Update mission and allowable land-use under current zoning.
- Provide a new seasonal opportunity for the general public to enjoy the outdoors in North Lake Tahoe.
- Provide a basecamp with easy access to surrounding outdoor activities, including over 50 miles of hiking and mountain biking trails.
- Have the potential to drive additional business to local retailers and merchants.
- Help correct the imbalance of camping opportunities throughout the Tahoe Basin.
- Offer more families the opportunity to enjoy an outdoor experience and reconnect with nature in North Lake Tahoe.
- Provide Tahoe Rim Trail users with the ability to restock water, re-supply, shower and camp.
- Provide mountain bike enthusiasts and outdoor adventures a place to enact repairs or pick-up essential parts.
- Offer a new opportunity for group assembly for local and regional Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Boys & Girls Club members, and other public organizations supporting children.
